


## The Gift of Education

## Get to Know CWF

The Colorado Women's Education Foundation (CWF) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization originally incorporated as the Colorado Business and Professional Women's Foundation in 1976. The Foundation was initially established for the purpose of providing grants, fellowships, scholarships, and loans to Colorado residents. Over the years, the Foundation's name changed and the awards gradually evolved to become scholarships for women of non-traditional student age. CWF realizes the value and power of education and it achieves its mission by supporting these women in the pursuit of their higher education goals.

CWF invests in a special demographic of women. Since our recipients are older, they may not be eligible for grant programs or are excluded by other scholarship programs. They are often single—having been widowed, divorced, or abandoned—and may be caring for multiple dependents, including children and aging parents, and are challenged to support themselves and their families, in addition to completing their education. CWF believes education is the key to helping women become more economically self-sufficient. CWF's financial and personal investment in these women has many positive impacts extending to their families and further into their communities.

## Scholarships

CWF awards scholarships to Colorado women of non-traditional student age for study at accredited educational institutions of higher learning or vocational training in Colorado. Applicants must be at least 25 years old and demonstrate U.S. citizenship, Colorado residency, academic potential, financial need, career goals, leadership skills, and community involvement.

The CWF Board of Trustees reviews the applications and awards scholarships without regard to race, ethnicity, religion, or sexual preference. The selection process is more difficult than ever given the record number of applications the Foundation receives and the high quality of achievement portrayed by these women. The number and the amount of the scholarships vary depending on available funds.
